

Announcing a new Trap-Neuter-Return program!

Starting February 2010

Communities throughout the tri-county area now face a population crisis of homeless cats, many of them feral and too wild to be placed in homes. They reproduce rapidly and, as their numbers grow, so does the noise, odor and other problems. But now there's something you can do!!

Trap-neuter-return (TNR) involves trapping all the cats in a colony, getting them neutered, adopting out the kittens and friendly cats, then returning the wild adults to their territory and providing them with food and shelter. TNR eliminates or significantly reduces the noise from fighting, odor from spraying and more litters of kittens.

This new program will provide the framework to assist feral cat takers access to resources so that they can manage their colonies and prevent unwanted litters. The program is designed to change the lives of feral and free roaming cats so they lead a better life and ease the burden on their caregivers.

Program consists of:

- Learning best practices and the latest information on TNR
- Access to the program benefits
 - Free rabies/distemper with s/n
 - Loan traps with no charge (credit card required, only charged if trap isn't returned at the agreed on time period)
 - Quick appointments
 - Special feral cat day specials – lower pricing
 - Invites to feral cat get together's
 - Personal mentoring and Additional assistance
 - Special pricing on food (when available)
